	 Case Management Plan (CMP) - for a student in Category H: Gives a clear indication that the student is a behavioural priority not only for the school but also for other community services/agencies Lists the behavioural goals and behavioural difficulties that place the student at serious risk to themselves and others Lists the members of the case management team with title and their responsibilities. May be combined with the IEP, but the CMP information must be placed in an exclusive section for behavioural concerns.
