For St. Andrew's Regional High School in Victoria, BC, and other Island Catholic Schools

Reporting to the Principal and Superintendent, the *Director of International Education* is responsible for the recruitment of international students from a variety of countries and supporting those students and their families while in Canada. Although the focus is on recruiting for St. Andrew's Regional High School (a Grade 8 to 12 Catholic high school with approximately 350 students), the person is expected to recruit for our elementary schools where possible.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Recruit international students for short and long stay educational experiences
- Attend recruitment fairs and engage in agent visits
- Collaborate with other colleagues in the industry
- Travel abroad two to three times per year
- Create effective agency partnerships and maintain relationships
- Review and evaluate all international applications (paper and skype) to determine whether a student should be accepted into the international program; also includes preparation of acceptance letters and invoicing families
- Provide international families with support in acquiring immigration documents, study permits, medical insurance, Visa, custodianship, etc.
- Communicate regularly with families and students (enrollment and ongoing school support)
- Provide ongoing student support at the school level (academic, spiritual activities, etc.)
- Work collaboratively with teachers who teach the international students
- Work with the academic counsellor and administration to create student timetables, based on student needs
- Work collaboratively with homestay coordinator to support student placement
- Oversee homestay coordinator and support that employee as needed
- Understand and stay abreast of Ministry of Education and government regulations for international students
- Research requirements for students from other countries to study in Canada.
