ERASE Bullying Level 1 (Sometimes referred to as Level 1A)	Ensuring Safe and Caring School Communities	None	Online format (in development)	Schools must have 2 staff members trained in Safe & Caring Communities. It may be the Primary SSC or any other staff member who supports students in school safety. Training needs to be current within two years.
ERASE Bullying Level 2	Basic Violence Threat Risk Assessment/Basic VTRA	None	2-day workshop	Principal (now designated as Primary Safe School Coordinator-SSC) One additional SSC at either school or association level. Training needs to be current within two years.
ERASE Bullying Level 3	Advanced Violence Threat Risk Assessment/Advanced VTRA	Basic VTRA	2-day workshop	Optional Note: Advanced VTRA does not supersede the Ensuring Safe and Caring School Communities or Basic VTRA training requirements. A person with Advanced VTRA must have the other trainings current within two years to fulfill compliance requirements.
DTA - Digital Threat Assessment (Sometimes referred to as Level 1B)	Basic Digital Threat Assessment/Basic DTA	None (Basic VTRA is helpful)	1-day workshop	School must have support available from a Safe School Coordinator (Primary SSC, Additional SSC or Association SSC). Training needs to be current within two years.
	Advanced Digital Threat Assessment/Advanced DTA	Basic VTRA & Basic DTA	1-day workshop	Optional
Erase Bullying Level 4	Train-the-Trainer Basic VTRA	Basic & Advanced VTRA	3-day workshop through North American Center for Threat Assessment and Trauma Response	Optional Participant pays full cost – No MoE funding for Train-the-Trainer
