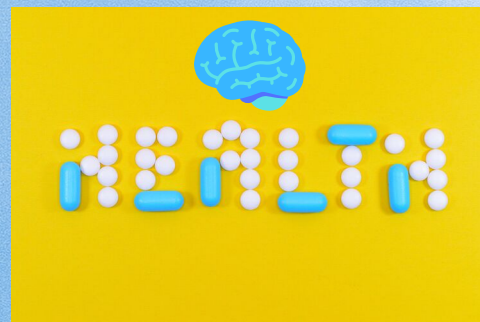

The Well-being BC website will contain a variety of resources including expert videos that introduce key Social-Emotional Learning concepts and school-based videos that show the concepts in action; viewing guides; infographic summaries; teaching resources; and an assessment & growth plan tool kit.
